Abstract submission

Abstract must be in English, up to 250-300 words. Authors cannot submit more than two contributions as first author. When submit the abstract, authors must select whether oral presentation or poster presentation.

Full paper submission

Following the acceptance of abstracts, authors who selected both oral and poster presentations will be required to submit full papers until the deadline. The format will be provide by word template on web-site. All papers will be peer-reviewed by 2 or 3 reviewers.

Congress Proceedings

The paper submission includes abstract and full paper. The congress proceedings will be distributed in hard copy (abstracts) and electronic version (full papers).

Awards

APD Best Paper will be selected by pre-screening process during a review and the Award Committee composed by executive committee.
