1. Our vision and mission

IAHR Nanjing Hydraulic Research Institute YPN (IAHR-NHRI-YPN) is a chapter formally established in Nanjing in May 2018 under the guidance of the IAHR China Chapter and the support of the Nanjing Hydraulic Research Institute. The number of registered members of the chapter has reached 146 by 2023. The daily activities of the IAHR-NHRI-YPN are organized and managed by the executive committee. The executive committee includes 1 president, 2 vice-president, and 6 executive member.

In 2022, YPN completed a lot of work and achieved good results. Once again, we awarded the honor of "The most active YPNs". Receiving this honor is not only a recognition of our past work but also a motivation for us to strive for higher standards in our future endeavors. In 2023, although many countries are in the phase of recovering from the COVID-19 pandemic, YPN is also overcoming all difficulties to organize more academic activities for students and enhance academic exchanges among members. It is the goal of the new Executive Committee to enhance everyone's knowledge and feelings by strengthening exchanges.



2. Main goals and key objectives in 2024

In 2023, YPN faces many new challenges. Its main tasks include (a) the production of recruitment publicity, (b) the change of the executive committee, (c) volunteer activity, (d) participating in academic competitions and (e) holding the doctoral academic forum.

(a)&(b) In September 2023, the recruitment of new members of this year was carried out, and 48 new members were received this year through propaganda, poster posting, online publicity and other means. At present, the total number of YPN members in our hospital is 146. At the same time, the change of the Executive Committee was completed. At present, the Executive Committee has one president, two vice presidents, and six executive members, which is the largest executive committee since the establishment of YPN.

(c) YPN encourages our members to engage in volunteer activities that complement their academic pursuits. The aim is to foster a community of service-minded scholars who are committed to making a positive impact both within the academic community and in wider society.
