What is the IAHR label?

A new labelling system aimed that acknowledges the **quality of education and training programmes** tailored for the water sector

Context



Urgent action and skilled water professionals are crucial for achieving **SDG 6**. Prioritising their education and training benefits not only SDG 6 but also addresses **climate change, food security, biodiversity, energy transition, and social development**.

Objectives



Recognise institutions promoting and implementing excellence in training and education programmes for competent and skillful professionals in the water sector.

Advantages



- Public confidence statement from an independent international water organisation.
- Recognition of quality education and training programmes for the water sector.
- Alignment of education with water professionals' needs.
- Assurance that academic awards meet international standards.

Who can apply



Any institution or organisation providing **vocational training, BSc, MSc and PhD programmes** focusing on water-related education and training.
